Configuring Browser

Enlighten makes use of technology such as Java and VB Script (to launch external applications). To function correctly, the security settings in Internet Explorer must be configured for each machine that runs enlighten, to ensure that it has the necessary permissions to utilize this technology.

The following instructions describe how to safely adjust the security settings in Microsoft Edge, Google Chrome and Mozilla Firefox so that enlighten can function correctly.



Configuring Google Chrome

To configure the Pop-ups blocker to allow pop-ups from enlighten the following steps can be followed:

- 1. Open Google Chrome and in the top-right corner, click the Chrome menu \equiv .
- 2. Click the **Settings** button.
- 3. Scroll to the Privacy & Security group and select Site Settings.
- 4. Scroll to the **Pop-ups and redirects** group and select it.




Figure 1: Pop-ups and redirects

- 5. To allow enlighten pop-up click the **Add** button next to **Allow**.
- 6. Enter the enlighten site URL in the **Site** text box.

7. To add the enlighten site to the Allow pop-ups list click the **Add** button.

To allow the **enlighten cookies** to be saved to the user's workstation so that the SSO Access Token is retained, the cookie settings must be enabled for the enlighten website. If enlighten cookies cannot be saved the user will be required to enter their domain credentials every time they open a new enlighten session. To save this configuration in Chrome, follow these steps:

- 1. Open a **Chrome** browser window.
- 2. Ensure the latest updates have been installed.
- 3. At the top right, click on the ellipsis (three dots)
- 4. Open Settings.
- 5. Scroll to the **Privacy & Security** option and select **Site settings**.




Figure 3: Navigate to Site settings

- 6. Navigate to the **Third-party cookies** option and expand.
- 7. Navigate to the Customized behaviors option and select the **Add** button.




Figure 4: Customized behaviour options

8. Enter the organization's enlighten website URL, for example http://[servername]/enlighten and select the **Add** button.

9. **Close** Chrome settings.



Configuring Mozilla Firefox

To configure the Pop-ups blocker to allow pop-ups from enlighten the following steps can be followed:

- 1. Open Mozilla Firefox and in the top-right corner, click the Firefox menu ≡.
- 2. Select Content Blocking.
- 3. Scroll to the **Permissions** group and click the **Exceptions** button next to **Block pop-up windows**.
- 4. Enter the enlighten site URL in the **Address of website** text box.
- 5. To add the enlighten site to the **Allow Website Pop-ups** list click the **Allow** button.




Figure 6: Allowed Websites - Pop-ups

6. To save the **Allow** Website - Pop-ups settings click the **Save Changes** button.

To allow the **enlighten cookies** to be saved to the user's workstation so that the SSO Access Token is retained, the cookie settings must be enabled for the enlighten website. If enlighten cookies cannot be saved the user will be required to enter their domain credentials every time they open a new enlighten session. To save this configuration in Firefox, follow these steps:

- 1. Open a Firefox browser window.
- 2. Ensure the latest updates have been installed.
- 1. At the top right, click on the **Settings** icon ⁽²⁾ .
- 2. Click on the Manage more Settings option.
 - (3) Manage more settings
- 3. Select Privicy & Security.
- 4. Navigate to Cookies and Site Data option.
- 5. Select the Manage Exceptions... option




Figure 7: Select Cookies and Site Data

6. Enter the organization's enlighten website URL, for example http://[servername]/enlighten and select the Allow button.





Figure 8: Adding enlighten website URL

Configuring Microsoft Edge

To configure the **Pop-ups blocker** to allow pop-ups from enlighten the following steps can be followed:

- 1. Open an Edge browser window.
- 2. Ensure the latest updates have been installed.
- 3. At the top right, click on the ellipsis (three dots)
- 4. Open Settings.
- 5. Scroll to the **Cookies and Site permissions** option and select.
- 6. In the task pane scroll to the **Pop-ups and redirects** option and select the **Add** button.




Figure 9: Allowed Websites - Pop-ups

7. Enter the organization's enlighten website URL, for example http://[servername]/enlighten.




Figure 10: Adding enlighten website

- 8. Select the **Add** button to effect the changes.
- 9. **Close** the browser settings.

- 3. Open Settings.
- 4. Navigate to Cookies and site permissions option
- 5. Expand the Manage and delete cookies and site data option




Figure 11: Cookies and site permissions

6. On the **Cookies and data stored / Cookies and site data** tab, navigate to the **Allow** section and select the **Add** button.




Figure 12: Selecting Add option on Cookies and site data

7. Enter the organization's enlighten website URL, for example http://[servername]/enlighten and check the tick-box for third-party cookies.




Figure 13: Enter enlighten website URL
